These programs are offered for all ages, any day, any time for as long as needed. Dinkelmann teaches these styles for Competition in OJA(Ontario JiuJitsu Association), OGA(Ontario Grappling Alliance) and OAWA(Ontario Amateur Wrestling Association). These styles are also great to learn if you're looking for something new to try and stay in great shape.

Dinkelmann teaches all classes with assistance from his senior students. Nathan holds a Brown Belt in JiuJitsu and has been wrestling since 1997 in the state of Michigan. In 2015, Nathan won gold in the Ontario JiuJitsu Association on two separate occasions and took silver also. Nathan has also started grappling programs in Kitchener and Mount Forest Ontario as well.

Dinkelmann Grappling Arts is a proud participant in the Renew Northern Wellington program, which is a collaborative initiative of the Town of Minto, Mapleton Township and the Township of Wellington North. It helps to put talented people into downtown storefronts to gain exposure, build their business, and become a sustainable enterprise. The program offers minimal risk and investment but is unlimited in its opportunities for success. "This literally has been my dream and passion since I first discovered martial arts in 1994.
